► **Run for the Kids** *by Pete*

The 3rd version of this benefit event for the Children's Advocacy Program took place on an overcast but warmish day on the Empire Lakes trails in John Topits Park in Coos Bay. Among the 55 listed finishers were five from the SCRC plus nine Angell Job Corps students brought from Yachats by Cynthia Rogers.

Doug Vesey was the overall champion of the 5 km run/walk. He covered the hilly course in a time of 21:19. Becky Edmonds and Joe Hallett tied for second in 28:33. They were followed by Pete Dawson (30:10) and Frank Searfus (32:56).

Kristy Harvey did her usual efficient job as race director. Thanks to Kristy and her volunteers.

► **Splint and Sprint** *by Pete*

The second annual 5 km run/walk boasted over 100 finishers this year, almost doubling the 2005 turnout for this benefit event for the Lower Umpqua Hospital Foundation in Reedsport. Among them were four SCRC members, led by Toby Gutoski who finished fourth overall in 20:21. Chris Csoros (25:51)

took third among the women. Bill (45:15) and Sharon (48:19) Everly came over from LaPine. Cynthia Rogers again brought a contingent of Angell Job Corps students.

► **Catching Slough Classic** *by Pete*

After what seemed like a forever-long bout of rainy weather, the gods smiled on the South Coast for the 12th edition of one of the oldest club events. The clouds hung around long enough to get the 10-miler finished, and a nice breeze helped to cool the runners on the way back.

Eric Engles led the SCRC runners in the 10-mile run/walk, edging out Tom Bedell by 4 seconds in 72:53 for both 2nd place and the Master's championship. Eric Gherke finished 5th overall.

Tracy Heley finished 3rd among the women in 85:24 and won the Master's award. Chris Csoros and Becky Edmonds tied for 2nd.

Jim Lawson set an age-group record finishing 4th in the 5 km event. He was followed by Nancy Morgan.

Proceeds from the event, which drew an all-time low of 40 entrants, benefit the Jennifer Turman Memorial Scholarship Fund. Thanks to generous donations from Jim Graves, Frank Searfus and Ward Wright, we raised more than enough to fund one scholarship.
